Central London Location

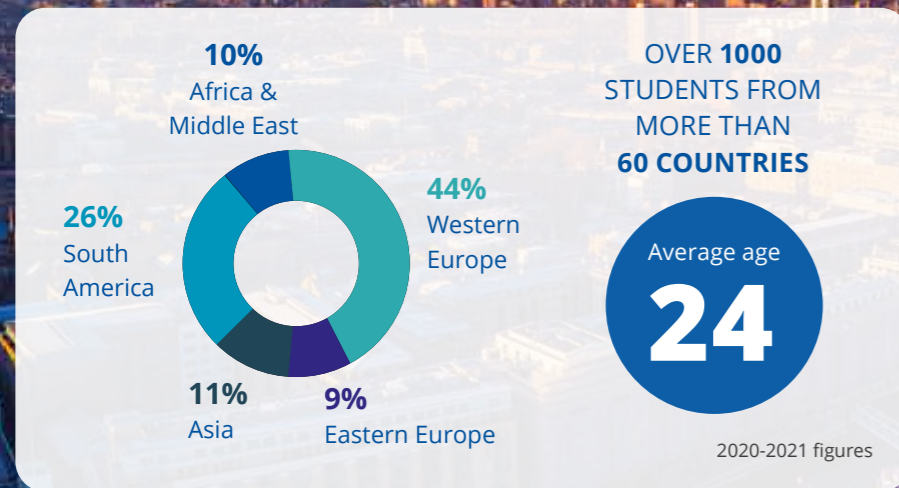
- The College occupies a historical Grade II listed building in a fantastic location in the historic area of Tower Hill (Central London, Zone 1) a short walk from the underground station.


